THIS MAP BELONGS TO

MAKE THIS MAP YOUR OWN

Mark your home on the map so you know where you are!

If your home is off the map, point the way to it with an arrow.

Find your school on the map and mark that too!

Mark the route you take from home to school. Can you find a shortcut?

Mark your friends' homes on the map. Find a route there too!

Find your favourite park on the map. How would you get there?

Where else would you like to explore?

Find somewhere new you would like to go.

Check your map and decide how to get there.

YOUR QUESTS

This map doesn't show hills! Your quest is to find them and draw them on! Which ones are the steepest? (you might need to explore a LOT to find out)

There are a few spots to see the Dreaming Spires of Oxford on the horizon. (Hint: check out Crescent Road.) Try to spot the spires on a clear day!

Ask a responsible adult to find somewhere they have never been. Your quest is to plan a route and lead them there!

How many playgrounds are on the map? Can you visit them all?

Find all the road names with animals hidden in them. Can you spot the two hiding in Cowley Road...?!
*there are lots of sneaky ones, we found 16!

REFLECTIVE PLACES

There are four blue stars marked on the map, showing some creative and artistic features in our neighbourhood.

What do you think they are designed for, and how do you feel when you see them?

Use the map to find:

Littlemore History Tree (installation)
Peace Symbol (artwork)
Organic Growth (sculpture)
Waterfalls (architecture)

OXFORD SAFARI

Each time you spot one of these animals, make a tick.

Count up your ticks when you've found them all - what animal did you see most?

Dragonfly	Heron
Beetle	Deer
Frog	Hedgehog

Find your favourite tree and mark it on your map.

Explore the parks and find a place to play, or do sports or find a peaceful place to have a rest.

Don't forget the blackberries are ripe in August and September!

Find a patch on the map to visit - don't forget to take a tub to collect them in

(try not to pick them from near a road or too low down where animals might pee!)
